

As outbreaks of the virus affect the ability to hold in-school classes, many students without devices and reliable access to the internet suffer when the decision is made to pivot to on-line learning. When Mary Kay Dore casually mentioned this to Anna Dudick recently, BGV Gives invited the school district to submit a grant request addressing this need. Having the ability to address immediate, unforeseen needs in the community by both BGV Gives and The Summit Foundation resulted in a grant award of \$21,000, half funded through BGV's Donor Advised Fund at the foundation and half from the Summit County Cares Fund. Collaborative partnerships like this happen throughout our community. It makes us smile just thinking about it!
